



What is Town Hall?

Town Hall is a place on Facebook where you can stay involved with your local government and community:

- See the names and contact information of local, state and federal government officials.
- Contact government officials directly through Facebook.
- Connect with government officials by following them.

Visit Town Hall at facebook.com/townhall.

Keep in mind that you may need to enter your address to see local government officials who represent your area. Some representatives may not appear in Town Hall at all if they're not on Facebook or haven't updated their Page with the political office they hold.

If you are an elected official, here's how to make sure your Facebook Page shows up for your constituents in Town Hall:

- Go to your Facebook Page
- Click the About tab
- Under Career and Personal Info, find the Political Info section
- Click +Enter office currently held
- Select the country, level of government, and fill out all fields
- You may also enter a "Preferred Name" if the name you're known by (or that is on your Facebook Page) does not match the legal name with which you were elected
- Click Submit

If you do not see these features or options, make sure that:

- a) you are using a Facebook Page (not a Facebook Profile);
- b) your Page is in the "Government Official," "Politician," or "Political Candidate" category. You can change your category on the About tab;
- c) your Page is using the "Politician" template. You can update your Page template from the Edit Page tab of your Page Settings.
